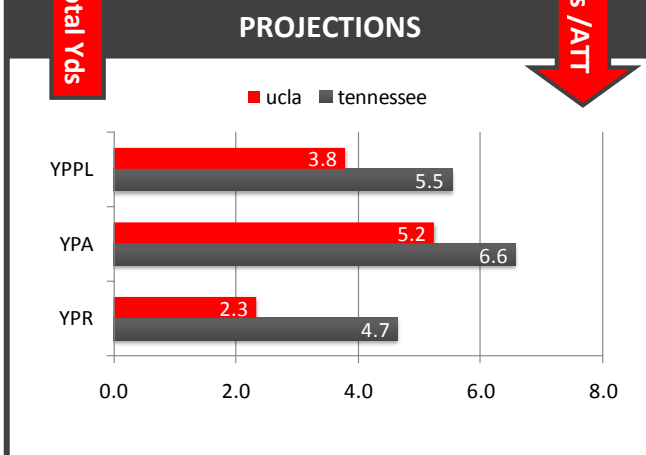
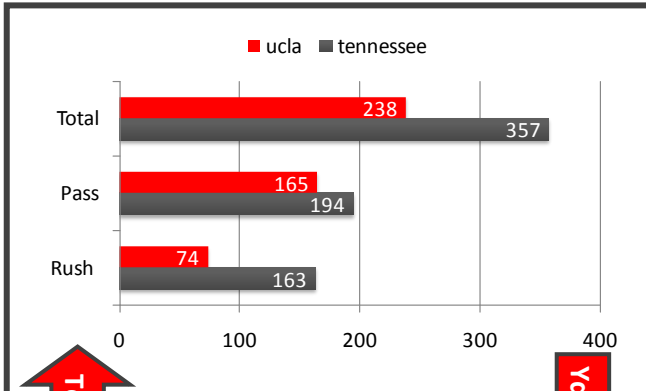

**KEY 'S TO THE GAME**

- ÷ How does Kiffin's new O fare versus a legitimate BCS team (I rank WKU as the worst D1A team TY). Can Chow's O in yr 2 improve over Lys poor 283 ypg & 17.7 ppg average
- ÷ Who wins the Turnover battle? Both teams vs inferior comp LW each turned it over 3 times (as well as each forcing 3 TO's). 6 total TO's in each game is SCARY & a huge gamble.
- ÷ Which team will control the Line of Scrimmage? Each team returns talent and depth at both DL & OL,. UCLA has an inexperienced QB & UT still has a new Off, so controlling the LOS will be critical.

**SUMMARY**

A very interesting matchup, particularly given the fast start UT jumped out to last week (albeit vs a woefully overmatched WKU team), but still they put away a bad team which is what they are supposed to do. UCLA looked anything but sharp vs SDSU (on offense) averaging just 3.8 ypr and 5.2ypppl. That isn't a good sign vs what should be a very good UT defense. The UCLA defense looked good, allowing only 4.4 yppl and just 2.2 ypr, so it will be interesting to see how they match up to a pretty experienced UT oline (4 starters w/ 6+ starts returning). Our math calls for a 28-16 UT win, and the average model score is 27-16, but with the TO situation from LW there is a lot of risk in this game I'll side with my math and UT, due to their edge on Def, and being at home . However at -10 and little line value i'll be an innocent bystander. **UT28 UCLA 17.**
