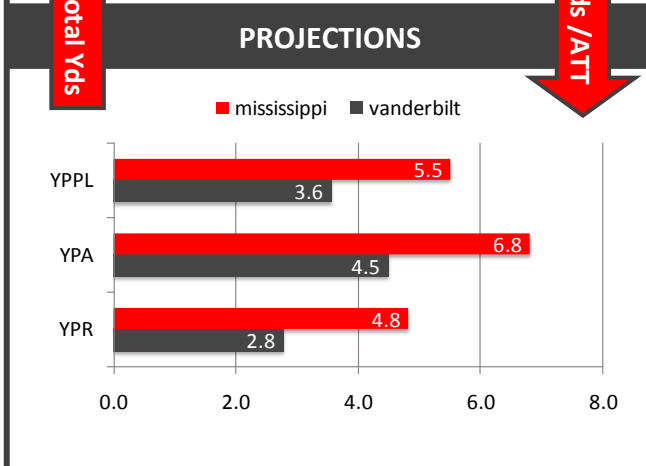
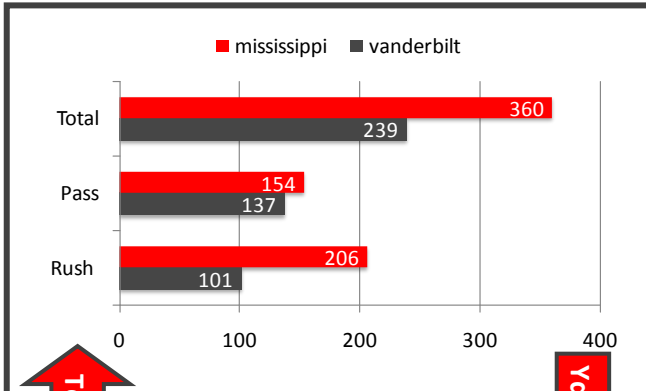
Mississippi is a #3 recommended play (1 Units)

KEY 'S TO THE GAME

- ÷ Can Vandy get anything going on offense v SEC foe? 210 yd v LSU TY, 157 v Miss St TY, and 202 LY vs Ole Miss isn't a favorable sign. Add in a pretty good Miss D TY (allowed 285 @ 4.2 yppl LW to USC) and I am pretty certain the Does will struggle
- ÷ Can the Ole Miss off get back on track after LWs performance @ USC? USC on Thurs night is a pretty electric place (USC so 6-2 SU in recent TH night games), so my guess is they'll bound back pretty strong.
- ÷ How does Vandy react to by far the best O they've seen TY (the average O they've faced has ave 277ypg @ 4.3 yppl)

SUMMARY

Ole Miss continues to struggle out of the gate in SEC play (0-6 SU L6Y) losing LW @ USC. For those who don't think a week can make a huge difference...LY in SEC opener OM has 6TOs to Vandy and loses SU (despite allowing only 202 yds) then goes to UF the following week as a 22 point dog and wins SU. Vandy has no offense, and until they prove otherwise don't mind going against them, particularly here vs one of the best Os in the SEC (preseason math called for 450 ypg & 8.5 yppl). Even with the limited data TY OM is still ave 366ypg (+0.9 yppl). Projections call for 203-238 for VU, they have 12 combined points in 2 SEC games TY, so will be lucky to hit 10. 50% of our math calls for 450 & 40+ for Ole Miss, while the other half has 366-385 & 28. Model average is 35-12 Ole Miss, which seems right to me. **Ole Miss 35 Vandy 13. Ole Miss is a #3 recommended play at -8.5.**
