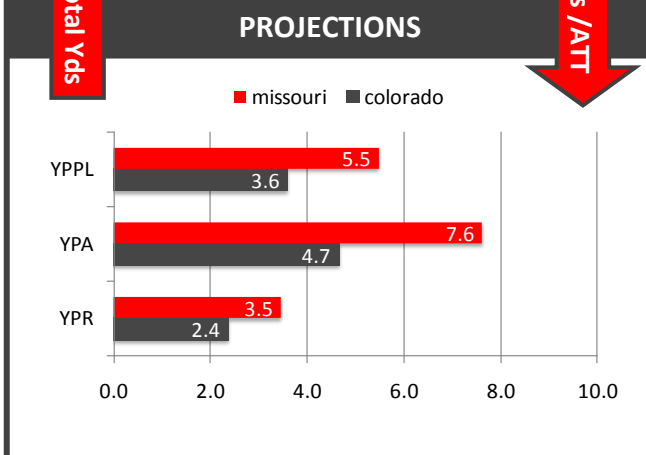
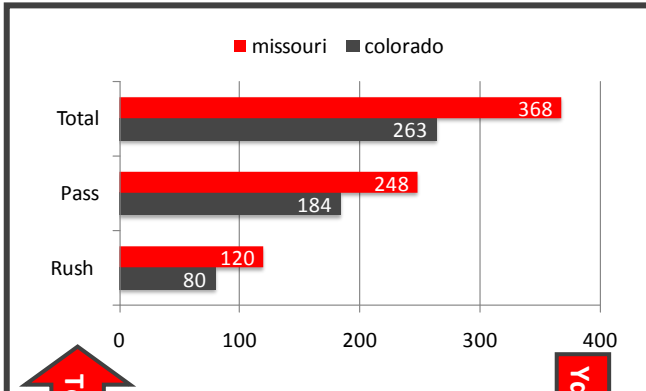

KEY 'S TO THE GAME

- ÷ Can a poor Col O (302 ypg@ 4.2 yppl (-0.8 yppl), incl 2.8 ypr @ -0.6 ypr) sustain anything v a very good Mizzou D that is +1.0 ypr allowing only 4.7 yppl TY (+1.0 yppl).
- ÷ Can Mizzou get it back on track after 3 SU L's vs the cream of the crop in the B12 (Neb, Ok St, and Texas)? They are still ave a respectable 372 ypg (5.3 yppl) and face a Col D allowing 379 ypg (5.7 yppl).

SUMMARY

I don't see much that Colorado is going to be successful at in this game where they project a -1.6 ypr, -2.2 ypa, and -1.9 yppl disadvantage and only project 263 yds offense (3.6 yppl). Mizzou has struggled a lot lately, somewhat respectable given the comp they've faced, and my sense if they'll start to resemble the team that left out to a 5-0 start, as they get a fairly soft Colorado D allowing 4.2 ypr and 5.7 yppl. Mizzou projects 5.5 yppl @ 367. 67% of our models have under 20 for Col (the others have only 23-25), and given the prospects of under 300 yards offense the 0-10 is definately in play. Mizzou has over 31 in about 50% of our models, which makes this a little closer than i'd otherwise like (the other 50% have 26-28), but Mizzou is 9-0 the L3 years in these type games (favorite of 3.5-10) with an average score of 43-21. **Mizzou 31 Colorado 18. Mizzou is a #3 recommended play at -4.**
