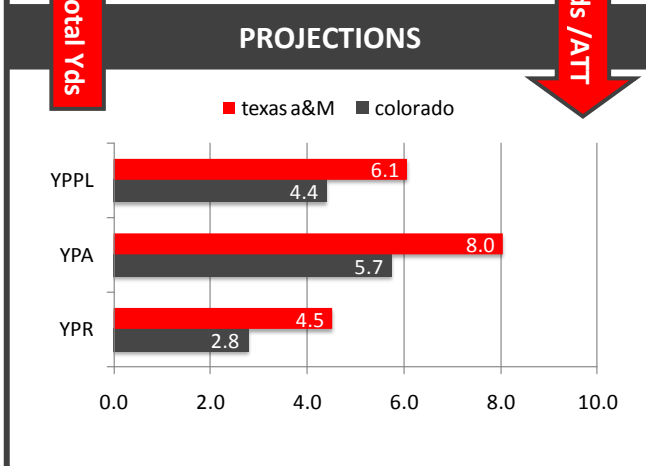
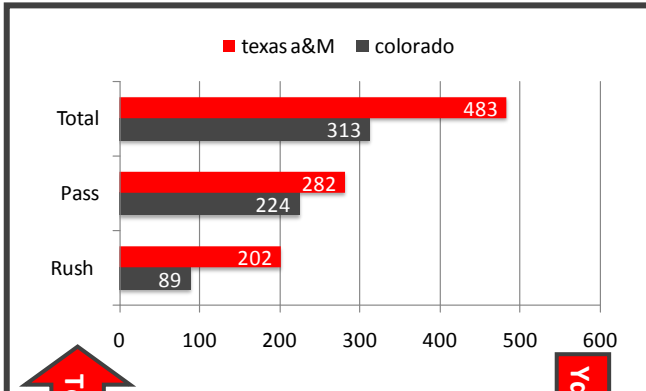

KEY 'S TO THE GAME

- ÷ Can a bad Col rush D (allow 154 ypg & 4.2 ypr) slow down a very good TAMU Rush attack (ave 191 ypg, 4.3 ypr @ +0.5 ypr).
- ÷ Colorado continues to be abysmal offensively (286 ypg, 4.1 yppl @ -0.9 yppl) and even worse on the ground where they ave just 2.5 ypr (76 ypg). They face a decent TAMU D that is +0.1 yppl TY (5.7 yppl to teams that ave 5.8 yppl).

SUMMARY

We went against Col LW week in nearly an identical situation as a 3 pt dog @ home v Missouri, and have no problems doing it again with a TAMU O that projects nearly the same advantages. TAMU projects over 200 on the ground (4.5 ypr) and 470-483 yds total offense (6.1 yppl). Colorado with huge situational disadvantages in every facet of their offense looks to ave only 4.4 yppl (less than TAMU looks to gain rushing), including just 2.8 ypr for 312-316 yds. 60% of our models call for 36 for TAMU, with the balance @ 31. Asking for 28 points from Colorado given just 312-316 is asking a lot and not one of my models has them with more than 24, which given the offensive production is on the high side (my sense is more like 13-17).

TAMU 33 Colorado 23, TAMU is a #2 Recommended play at -3.
