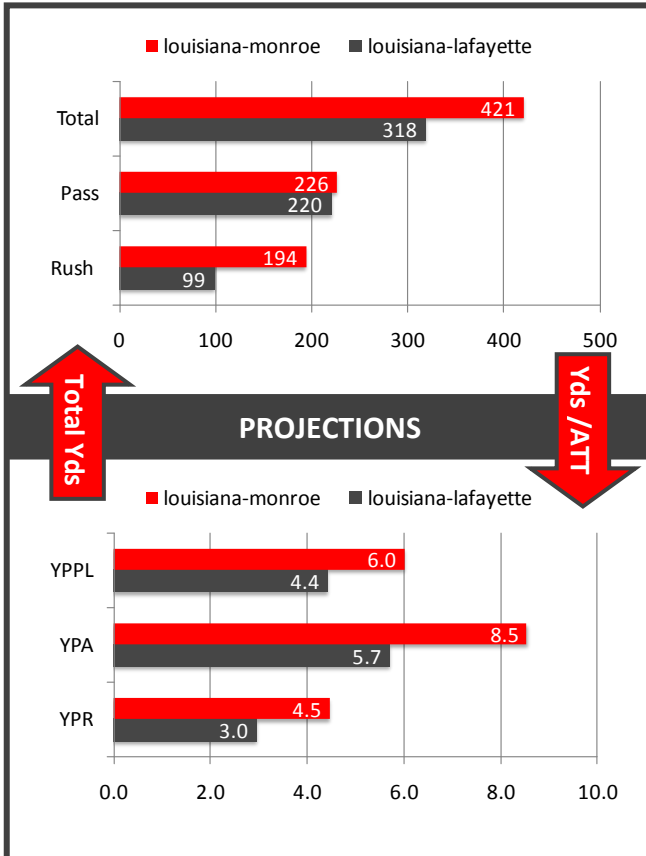
KEY 'S TO THE GAME

÷ ULM ave 403yppg(5.9 yppl) including 4.5 ypr & 186 ypg rushing vs a ULL D allowing 175 ypg rush (4.4 ypr) & 404 ypg @ 5.9 yppl. No surprise that ULM projects 4.5 ypr (194 yds) & 6.0 yppl (420 yds)

÷ ULL is -0.8 ypr (3.8 ypr despite playing Ds that are allowing 4.6 ypr) and face a ULM D that is very good vs the rush (3.4 ypr @ +0.5 ypr). Equates to a -1.3 ypr disadvantage and just 2.95 ypr (99 yds rushing). Add to that a -1.2 ypa and -1.1 yppl and ULL projects just 4.4 yppl (318 yds).

SUMMARY

ULM matches up very favorably to ULL in this game, as they ave a 41-28 run-pass ratio and get a ULL D allowing 40 atts/game @ 4.4 ypr. ULM also projects a very healthy advantage in the air (1.4 ypa) which given their success on the ground should be mutually reinforcing. All in all I don't see how a ULL O that has struggled TY (-1.0 yppl) keeps up, and our projections of just 4.4 yppl (equal to ULMs production on the ground) and just 318 yds supports that. Our models are very consistent with 27-31 for ULM and just 19-20 for ULL, but given the yardage disparity I think the upside is to ULM in both sides (30-35 isn't out of the question for ULM and 10-17 isn't unrealistic for ULL).
